In honor of the recent European Open, these exercises touch on some of the challenges presented. There is usually a trickle-down effect from major events to challenges presented in North American courses, and as a competitor you want to try to stay just ahead of the wave in terms of what the trend will be for types of challenges.

Your dog must be comfortable with both staying out, for example on a 270, and coming in between obstacles, so make sure you have clear signals for both skills. In these challenges, many of the obstacles are not square to the path of the dog, so his commitment point may not be as strong as usual. Make sure he is fully committed before moving on. That doesn't mean he's over the jump, but that you would bet \$50 he was going to take it.


