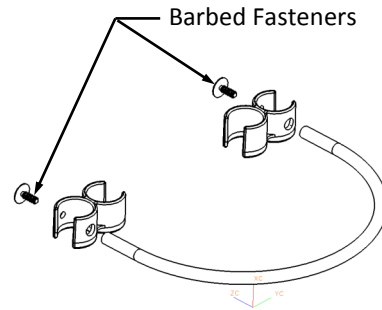
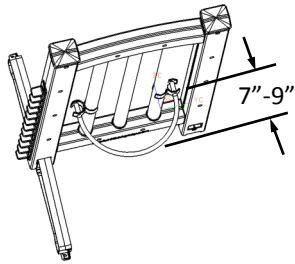


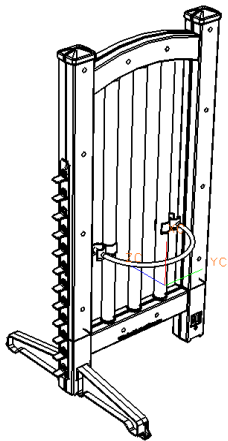
Backside Jumping Aid Assembly Instructions

1.) Your new jumping aid comes with tubing that is 28" long. You will most likely want to trim it to an appropriate length for your wing jump. We recommend the tubing measures 7"- 9" from the wing. (See diagram). If you are using this aid with a Clip and Go wing jump we recommend you cut the tubing to 22" long.



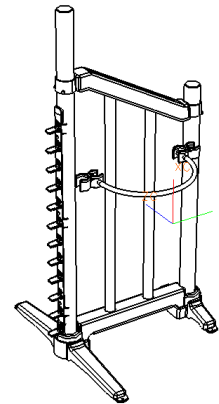
2.) Once you have trimmed the tubing to the desired length secure it to the clip using the barbed fasteners. (See diagram)

3.) Your jumping aid can attach to either 1" PVC (1.31" OD) or 1 1/4" PVC (1.62" OD). If you attach the clip to the larger 1 1/4" PVC it will be stretched and will no longer stay secure on the smaller 1" PVC pipe.

The clips can be positioned outward to attach to the outside of the wing jump panel or it can be positioned inward to attach to the inside

WARNING:

Never position this training aid on the landing side of the jump. Your dog could be injured if he lands in the loop.
