

Bootlock fitting is quick and easy:

- Loosen the screw on the Bootlock, place it around the boot (trunk), hatch, or door pin, and tighten the screw securely to prevent the Bootlock from detaching.
- 2. Shut the boot or door and securely engage the boot latch into the hooped end of the Bootlock.
- 3. You can now operate your vehicle's locking system as usual.
- 4. To remove the Bootlock, simply unlock your vehicle and press the boot release button or lift the boot release handle to disengage the Bootlock from the boot latch.
- 5. Loosen the screw from the boot or door pin and store it in a safe place for future use.

IMPORTANT: Unlocking your car with a key or your keyless fob will only unlock the Bootlock, it will not release the Bootlock from the latch. If you normally have to lift a handle to open the back doors or tailgate of your vehicle, then you must follow the same process to remove the Bootlock: unlock the vehicle and then lift/open your door handle to release the Bootlock from its position. We highly recommend watching the demonstration video.
